

Fourth UK Cytometry Core Managers Forum

This intensive one-day workshop will focus on topics of immediate interest to new, aspiring and established cytometry facility managers. It will consider both fundamental aspects of core management such as evaluation and metrics of service delivery and also other features such as education, networking and collaboration of cores, and career development.

The format of the meeting will be round-table discussions, led and supported by moderators. The number of participants will be limited to a maximum of 35 to enable such discussions. The meeting will provide an ideal opportunity for networking, aiming to bring together established senior peers with the more junior members of the profession, so as to interact in a friendly environment. Participants are encouraged to bring their real-life scenarios to the meeting.
